With Adobe® PDF JobReady™, it's like we hauled our prepress department into your office. Now you can create your own document, proof it on your desktop and place an order. And it's as easy as selecting your print button.

No more missing files and fonts. No more burning artwork to a CD. It's like you are sitting right next to one of our designers and having total access to your own customer service representative.

Before you start using PDF JobReady, you need to download and install the PDF JobReady software:

- Before download, make sure your system is running Mac OS X and you already have Adobe[®] Reader[®] 6 or 7 installed on your computer. Both are required to run the PDF JobReady software.
- To download the PDF JobReady software, go to the PDF JobReady page on our website. Save the file to your desktop (this is a 22 MB file). The PDF JobReady software is downloaded as a Stufflt compressed archive file, titled jobready.mac.pkg.sit. Double-click this icon to unstuff the file to your desktop. The file will then appear as jobready.macx.pkg.
- To ensure trouble-free installation, we recommend you restart your computer before you begin. The speed of your computer will determine the speed of the installation.

PDF JobReady Installation

 Double-click the jobready.macx.pkg file. A pop-up window will display that says "This installer package needs..." Click Continue.



2. A pop-up window appears that states "Please quit all running applications..." Click OK.



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
3. You will now be able to simply click through the installation, continuing through the initial screens, agreeing to the license agreement and finally clicking the Install button to complete installation. Disregard the Print or Save buttons as you walk through the process. The default installation settings will work with any system, so no modifications need to be made during this process.



 After clicking Install, an authentication box may pop up. Enter your predetermined user name and password then click OK.



Now PDF JobReady will install to your computer. This may take a few minutes.



Once the screen reads "The software was successfully installed," click Close.



 Your computer is now equipped with the PDF JobReady software, and ready for PDF file creation. Continue to next page for test file creation procedures for Mac OS X.

Test File Creation Procedures For Mac OS X


- 1. Ensure your computer is connected to the internet.
- 2. Open TextEdit and create a document.
- 3. Once your file is prepared, select the print option.
- 4. On the print screen, ensure that the following are selected:
 - Printer dropdown list is set to "Send to cuadvantage.com."
 - Copies and pages dropdown list is set to "Send to cuadvantage.com."
 - "Preview with" is set to Adobe Reader 6 or 7.
- 5. Then click Print.



The preview window and the "Send to cuadvantage.com" box will appear. Click Connect.



 Next, the Adobe PDF JobReady window will appear. Enter your name, e-mail address, and any other information needed, then click Send Now.



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A progress bar shows the file is uploading to our printshop. This may take a few minutes, depending on file size.



 Once the PDF JobReady upload is finished, your file has been sent to our website. Close this window with the red close button in the top left corner to exit PDF JobReady.



10. Now hit cancel on the "Send to cuadvantage.com" dialog box and close your document. You have completed the Adobe PDF JobReady test print process.
