How to Make a Personal Budget Worksheet

(An example of a simple budget sheet for kids)



Money (Income)	How Much Money do I Have?	How I Got the Money
Weekly Allowance	\$5.00	\$5.00 for doing my chores
Gift (Special reward, birthday, etc.)	\$8.00	\$3.00 for helping dad clean out the car. \$5.00 for birthday.
Other (Miscellaneous)	\$0.30	Found two dimes & two nickels in the couch!
Total (All of My Money)	(\$5 + \$8 + \$0.30 =) \$13.30	
What I Want to Buy	How Much Does it Cost?	Why I Want to Buy It
Minions DVD	\$19.00	I really enjoyed the movie and I want to watch it with my cousins when they come to visit in three weeks
Caramel Popcorn	\$3.00	To eat while we're watching the Minions movie!
What it All Costs	(\$19 + \$3 =) \$22.00	
Do I Have Enough Money (All of My Money - What It All Costs)	\$22.00 - \$13.30 = \$8.70 (I do not have enough money yet. I need to save \$8.70 more.)
